

Instructions

OR follow these steps:

The shapes in the quilt blocks and their coordinating layers are named according to the alphabet. Find the layer with the coordinating letter of the shape you want to change. Click on the smart object symbol of that layer to add your design.

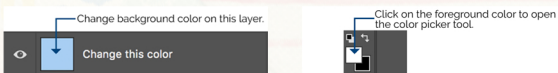


A new document will open, where you can paste your design and size/rotate according to how you want it. Close and save, and your design will be loaded into the shape on your quilt block mockup!

PRO TIP: First load your designs as patterns into Photoshop. Then just create a new pattern fill layer in the smart document and choose your pattern! It's much easier to change the scale and rotation of your designs this way! This is shown in the instructional video mentioned at the top of this page!

To change the Background Color:

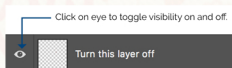
Select the layer on the bottom, click on your foreground color, and the color picker will pop up. Choose your color, click OK and use the paintbucket tool to fill the layer with your chosen color!



If you want to change the brightness and contrast of the whole image, just click on the little sun icon on the top layer, and the slider will pop up! Click on the arrow to the right of the pop up to close it again.



Remember to turn off the layer with the alphabet before you save your design as a jpeg or png.
